

J Dishcloth



J is for Jodi!

Supplies:

- 1 ball of kitchen cotton (I used Peaches & Creme 4 Ply Worsted Weight.)
- Size US 7 straight or circular needles

Gauge—Don't sweat it on this project. Just match your needle size with your yarn to create a fabric that has a drape you like.

Cast On 36 stitches

K 4 rows

Row 5: K4, P to last 4 st, K4

Row 6: K

Repeat Rows 5 & 6 four times.

Row 15: K4, P8, K8, P12, K4

Row 16: K15, P10, K11

Row 17: K4, P7, K10, P11, K4

Row 18: K15, P10, K11

Row 19: K4, P6, K5, P2, K4, P11, K4

Row 20: K15, P4, K2, P5, K10

Row 21: K4, P13, K4, P11, K4

Row 22: K15, P4, K17

Row 23: K4, P13, K4, P11, K4

Row 24: K15, P4, K17

Row 25: K4, P13, K4, P11, K4

Row 26: K15, P4, K17

Row 27: K4, P13, K4, P11, K4

Row 28: K15, P4, K17

Row 29: K4, P13, K4, P11, K4

Row 30: K10, P3, K2, P4, K4, P3, K10

Row 31: K4, P6, K16, P6, K4

Row 32: K10, P16, K10

Row 33: K4, P6, K16, P6, K4

Row 34: K10, P16, K10

Row 35: K4, P to last 4 st, K4

Row 36: K

Repeat Rows 35 & 36 four times.

K 4 rows

Bind Off

Weave in ends. Enjoy!
